

CHASING THE DRAGON POSTER CONTEST

OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The FBI and DEA have released “Chasing the Dragon: the Life of an Opiate Addict,” a documentary aimed at educating students and young adults about the dangers of addiction. In an effort to raise awareness on this epidemic, the FBI Cleveland Citizens Academy Alumni Association (FBICLEAAA), Robby’s Voice, DEA Cleveland, Westshore Enforcement Bureau, WKYC, a number of individual contributors and FBI Cleveland have all collaborated in order to spread the word about the Opiate addiction.

Students in grades 7-12 are invited to create and submit a poster that focuses on the consequences of using heroin and/or the misuse of prescription opioids.

1. This competition is available to all students in grades 7-12 who live within the area of responsibility of FBI Cleveland Division.
2. Individuals must complete the Entry Form, Submission Authorization/Media Release and submit the poster by **5:00 pm on April 30, 2019**. Poster entries will not be accepted if submitted after this date.
3. Poster must only contain original/non-copyrighted material. No branded material, logos, etc., may be used without express written permission from the copyright or trademark holder.
4. We reserve the right to disqualify any submission for any reason deemed necessary. Submitted posters will not be eligible if they contain or appear to contain:
 - a. Obscene material or language
 - b. Nudity, profanity, or gratuitous violence
 - c. Endorsement of illegal drug use, alcohol abuse, prescription drug abuse or other illegal activity
 - d. Derogatory characterization of any person or group
 - e. Any copyrighted or trademarked materials without express written consent from the copyright or trademark holder

Awards:

The contest will be broken down into three grade categories:

7th - 8th grade
9th - 10th grade
11th - 12th grade

Each grade category will have four winners:

ENTRY FORM/SUBMISSION AUTHORIZATION / MEDIA RELEASE

I understand that my artwork may be displayed at various locations around Northern Ohio and I give my permission for my name to be attached

I acknowledge that neither I nor my Child expect remuneration or compensation from Sponsors or any person or entity for the right and permission to use the Submission, as I grant such right and permission because of my desire to help Sponsors in its mission to help raise awareness in the fight against the heroin epidemic.

I, or as parent or legal guardian of the above-named child (the “Child”) and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, grant to Sponsors and its’ licensees, assigns, and successors in interest all right, title, and interest, throughout the world and in perpetuity, in and to my or the Child’s performance, appearance, name, voice, and the results and proceed thereof relating to my or the Child’s entry poster for the **Chasing the Dragon** PSA poster contest, including without limitation posters, photographs, videotapes, other media material that the Sponsors have developed or will develop.
