### COMPLETE APPLICATION FORMS

Be sure to include student and parent/guardian signatures on your application.

### INCLUDE ATTACHMENTS

Submit school transcripts, your personal essay, and (1) letter of recommendation.

### SUBMIT ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The scholarship application must be completed in its entirety, and submitted with all required attachments, postmarked by April 10, 2019. **NO** electronic or late submissions will be accepted.

## QUALIFICATIONS

- ✓ Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen who will be graduating from a high school in 2019 within the Northern District of Ohio, pursuing a post-secondary degree in criminal justice, law enforcement, forensic science or a related field.
- ✓ Applicant must enroll full-time (12 hours) for the 2019-2020 school year.
  - ✓ Applicant must have taken the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT).
  - ✓ Applicant must attend an accredited college, university or technical school (two or four year).
  - ✓ Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or equivalent GED score.
