# 2020 SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The FBI Cleveland Citizens Academy Alumni Association (FBICLECAAA) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit public service organization separate and apart from the FBI. To be completed and signed by you, the applicant and signed by your parent or guardian

### PART 2

To be completed and signed by your high school principal, college registrar or qualified school official

- Application **MUST** be postmarked by **March 25, 2020**.
- No electronic or late submissions will be accepted.
- Interviews will be held on April 27, 2020.
- Winners will be notified by May 8, 2020.
- Awards Ceremony will take place on May 27, 2020, location to be announced.

- **COMPLETE APPLICATION FORM**  
Be sure to include student and parent/guardian signatures on your application.
- **INCLUDE ATTACHMENTS**  
Submit school transcripts, (1) letter of recommendation and your personal essay.
- **SUBMIT ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**  
The scholarship application must be completed in its entirety and submitted with all required attachments, postmarked by March 25, 2020. No electronic or late submissions will be accepted.

## QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen who will be graduating from a high school in 2020 within the Northern District of Ohio, pursuing a post-secondary degree in criminal justice, law enforcement, forensic science or a related field.
- Applicant must enroll full-time (12 hours) for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Applicant must have taken the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT).
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or equivalent GED score.
